Adolphus, a draper's assistant was the son of Frederick and Susan Stanger. A married man aged 33 when he died from Pneumonia. He had only been in the army six weeks when he died having first been posted to Preston then onto Prees Heath, Whitchurch Shropshire for training. Prees Heath was a military training camp built in 1915 to house the new influx of volunteer recruits.
