

- 1892 Bacup became a postal town. Post office moved to opposite Market Hotel.<sup>145</sup>
- 1892 Bacup Technical School formed at Spring Gardens Mill, the school carried on until 1913 when the students were transferred to The New Bacup & Rawtenstall Grammar school at Waterfoot.<sup>30.148.</sup>
- 1892 Laying of foundation stones of the 2nd. Bacup Liberal Club. in Burnley Rd. Bacup. 1962 became A.B.D. Social Centre.<sup>147</sup>
- 1893 Oct. The Rossendale Bicycle & Tricycle Club.<sup>140.148</sup>
- 1893 Maden's Public Baths opened.<sup>30.149.</sup>
- 1893 Sir Henry Maden gave the recreation ground at Bankside.<sup>150</sup>
- 1893 The New Co-op Bakery opened.
- 1893 Conservative Club built. Opened 1894.<sup>151</sup>
- 1893 Royal Court Theatre opened, later named the Empire Theatre.

- 1894 Bacup Corporation Water Act.
- 1894 The Rossendale Express appeared on Wednesdays, Price a half penny.
- 1894 Union Boundaries Order.
- 1894 The Spotland portion of Bacup was transferred to the Haslingden Union. So as to form one township under the name of the township of Bacup.<sup>154</sup>
- 1894 Beulah Chapel rebuilt at Britannia after the devastating fire of 24th. Oct. 1892.
- 1894 Bacup Fire Station built Henrietta St. Demolished 1986.  
The Bacup Police Fire Brigade was formed in Feb. 94, the same year a Merryweather horse drawn fire engine was purchased. Previously the stock of fire appliances was three lengths of hose, one stand pipe, and one nozzle.  
In 1916 a motor fire engine was bought and in 1926, the first fire engine was sold for the sum of £23. At that date a trailer pump was purchased. May 1933, a further fire engine was purchased. A story is related about the early communication system, a fire broke out at Cowpe in 1893, a messenger had to be sent by tramcar for the Bacup Police Fire Brigade! and in 1896 Police were issued with bicycles.
- 1894 Undertaking of the Rossendale Waterworks Company vested in the Corporation of Bacup.
- 1894 Bacup Recreation Ground opened at Bankside.
- 1894/5 Tho'owlers bridge built to carry coal over Burnley Rd. Bacup, demolished for war scrap 1942.<sup>155</sup>
- 1895 Mount Olivet Baptist built.
