- 1904 Mount day school built, now demolished.
- 1906 A motor bus (omnibus) traversed Rochdale Rd., Bacup, & St. James St. in May, probably the first time in the history of Bacup. The route to be served by the Whitworth Vale Motor Bus Co.¹⁸²
- 1906 In August. The new bus of the Rossendale Division Carriage Co. arrived. Later it made several runs to Burnley.

- 1907 400,000 spindles and 10,000 looms in Bacup.
- 1907 Ross Mill Bacup, start of erection. Bacups last large cotton mill. Demolished 1982.³⁰
- 1908 Bacup Corporation purchased The Rossendale Valley Tramway Co.s in the Borough of Bacup.
- 1909 Tramway from Rawtenstall to Bacup electrified, opened 15 May
- 1909 Bacup Mechanics Institute leased to Bacup Corporation.
- 1909 Clover Hill the residence of Samuel Mclerie; created in 1872; some occupiers: James..... Crabtree, Rev. McCubbin, Thomas Barrowclough, J.S. Smith, etc.
- 1910 Post Office built Hempsteads Bacup. Opened 1911, 18th. Dec. Telephone exchange on the first floor, until it moved to Gas Street, Bacup.
- 1910 Cowpe Waterworks opened by the Mayoress Mrs. J.H. Maden.
- 1910 Bacup Golf Club formed, the first links at Cowtoot..... Farm. 1916 they moved to the present site at Bankside.¹⁸⁵
- 1910 August. 'Al' pictures at the Co-op Hall, in Aug.
- 1910 September. Opening of the 'Gem' picture palace, Public Hall. 'The Gem Electric Picture Co.¹⁹⁰ renamed 'The Kozy'.
- 1911 'Art' Pictures began at The Royal Court Theatre (Empire).
- 1911 Public supply of Electricity connected to Bacup.
- 1911/12 Bull's Head Inn demolished. King George V. built on site.
