- 1626 A corn mill mentioned in Cowpe.^{7&9.}
- 1632 Date stone Waggoner Tunstead, Stacksteads.¹⁸
- 1632 Recorded as the date when Boston Bridge was built. Dem. 1895
- 1666 " " Broadclough Hall + 1816.¹⁸
- 1669 Certain lands in Spotland were sold to different persons.¹⁴
- 1672 " " Fairwall Farm. About this date and after, to about 1750, many farms in the area were built.¹⁸
- 1692 The Chapel of Rossendale built on the Mechanics site Bacup Later used as a school. Demolished C 1844.³⁶
- 1702 DS. Stubblelee Hall.¹⁸. q.v. 1736, 1809, 1872.
- 1710 The date when the Chapel of Rossendale used by the Baptist, as a meeting house.³⁵
- 1713 A fulling mill was established at Hugh Mill Cowpe.⁸
- 1739 A date stone on Greens House, Todmorden Road, Bacup the home of Richard Lord¹⁸, 1770 DS. James Maden (1766-1849) resided there.
- 1746 The date when the Church of Rossendale was known as the Old Meeting House.³⁵
- 1747 The date stone of Crow Tree House, Stacksteads.¹⁸
- 1750-1850 The Industrial Revolution.⁷²
- 1750 The First Methodist Meeting House, Lane Head Lane, Bacup.⁵⁶
- 1751 A coal pit recorded at Backup. Run by a George Hargreaves X
- 1755 Rochdale to Burnley turnpike trust road built.¹⁶ Completed in 1810.²¹
- 1757 A coal pit run by Mr. Bauford, who paid 10 shillings to Poor Law. At Bacup.
- 1766 John Wesley preached in Bacup, for the second time.⁵⁶
- 1770/80 First cotton appeared in Bacup.¹⁷
