

- 1834-1838 Erection of Heathhill House, the home of Robert Munn.<sup>45</sup>
- 1835 "Hark-up-to Nugger" Said to be the date of establishment of this beer house which was on the site of the Market Hotel. (B&R News. 1865 26th. Aug)
- 1836 Fernhill House, an indenture of that date. (1863 B&R. 25/7)
- 1837 Bacup created a Consolidated Chapelry.<sup>42.46</sup>
- 1838 First Stacksteads Wesleyan Chapel on site of Stacksteads railway station. q.v. 1852.<sup>47</sup>
- 1838 Orchard Hill Chapel began, later named Waterbarn Chapel.<sup>48</sup>
- 1838 Waterside first Chapel built. Demolished 1953. (1953 BT. 16th. May. CC.)
- 1838 Great Flood at Cowpe.<sup>49</sup>

To Rochdale: The Tradesman from the Bull's Head Hotel and The Royal Forester from The George & Dragon Hotel every Mon. morning at 9 a.m. Carriers: to Blackburn., Wed. & Sat. To Burnley: Tues. Thurs. & Sat. To Halifax: Tues. Thurs. & Sat. To Manchester: Mon. Weds. & Fri. To Newchurch: Mon. Weds. & Fri. To Rochdale: Mons. Weds. & Fri. To Todmorden: occasionally. (compare 1854 & 1876) (Pigotts Dir)
- 1839 Bacup Mechanics Institute formed.<sup>50</sup> Opened in 1846
- 1840 The Holy Trinity Church built at Stacksteads. (<sup>2\*</sup> 1854)<sup>57</sup>
