

Springholme Mill



Today the site of Springholme Mill is known as Wynsors Shoes, the mill had originally been a spinning and weaving mill built by John Maden of Throstle Mill and the owner of the beautiful Rockliffe House.

By 1930, parts of the mill had been leased to Tunstead Needle Felt; the rest being used by John Maden & Son for warp knitting. On June 16th, 1937, the mill suffered a devastating fire leading to damage estimated at between £30,000 and £40,000 which resulted in the demolition of the surviving buildings, the canteen of Joshua Hoyle & Sons, later being built on the site.
